


First Grade Reading, Writing, & Word Work September 13, 2017

Stop and talk about important events/information while you are reading.

Compare and Contrast-

Discover the ways that authors show how people and things are the same and different.

Text-to-Self Connections-

Relate to the story using your own experiences.

On the back of this page is our classroom news related to the reading, writing, and word work that we will focus on during the next two weeks. This news will be sent home to you every other week throughout the school year.

You will notice that the boys and girls have two sets of word wall words and spelling words. On Mondays, the children will be tested on twelve words – six word wall words and six spelling words from the previous week.

The vocabulary word list consists of words that the children will encounter when we are reading and discussing books together as a class. Throughout the weeks, the children will work with the words. I also encourage you to use these words with your child at home.
